

## Regulations for two and more wheeled motor sport. Events and Championships organised by Straightliners Limited. (Governance in 2023 from NORA 92 Limited).

From documents available on the NORA 92 website, it appears that for many other types of two wheeled sport they produce detailed "Discipline Regulations". An online search has not found any NORA 92 Discipline Regulations appropriate to four wheeled motor sport.

NORA 92 is one of eleven 'authorising bodies.' It is stated that "An informal agreement prevails between the bodies not to Authorise events patently operating under the umbrella of another body".

*Any reference to a competitor, complying with the Standing or Specific Regulations of the following bodies being accepted into any Straightliners Limited managed events, does appear to be breaking this agreement: Auto Cycle Union (AC), IOPD or Motor Sport UK (MSUK).*

The Discipline Regulations of NORA 92 could or would be supported by additional written information for the competitor - such as Event Regulations; Supplementary Regulations; Championship Regulations.

The many types of motor sport events which are organised by Straightliners Limited include: Drag Racing; Sprinting; Top Speed (straightline); Land Speed Records (2-R-A); for a wide range of types and classes of vehicles, on two, three and four or more wheels; wheel driven and thrust powered. As well as 'Run What You Brung' (RWYB) classes.

Distinction is normally drawn between solo motorcycles, sidecars, trikes and three wheelers (cyclecars), scooters, quad machines, sprinters and drag bikes, thrust powered vehicles, circuit karts, road going and modified cars, single seater cars and dragsters, with differing fuelling and power unit types and number.

Events are held on as many as twelve (12) different locations across the UK and include a sandy beach. The length of the course ridden or driven can be from 1/8 mile to perhaps as long as 3 miles.

***The writing of Discipline Regulations would be for NORA 92. Straightliners Limited should be prepared to produce all of the other documents (some of which may already exist, but may require editing): Event Regulations; Supplementary Regulations; Championship Regulations.***
